IMPORTANT INFORMATION

This unit should be installed by a qualified competent person in accordance with all relevant legislation and regulations including building regulations and wiring regulations BS 7671. If in doubt contact a qualified competent person.

- Turn off all power supplying this equipment before working on or inside the equipment.
- Always use a properly rated volt-sensing device to confirm the power is off.
- Replace all devices, doors and covers before turning on the power to this equipment.
- These units have two supplies.

Failure to follow these instructions could result in serious injury or death.

DO NOT USE POWER TOOL SCREWDRIVERS ON ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS

To prevent damage to the inverter it is important that the inverter manufacturers' instructions are followed.


- To switch OFF: First isolate the PV AC isolator, then the DC isolator.
- To switch ON: First close the DC isolator, then the PV AC isolators.

Wiring diagrams

These units should have external wiring that is insulated and sheathed.

It is important for units with metering, that the AC feed from the inverter is connected directly to the meter 'incoming' terminals (Live terminal 1 & Neutral terminal N).


Circuit Diagram for Main Switch PV Unit









Circuit Diagram for Split load PV Unit
